Title of Report:	Primary Care Strategy 2015-2019

Purpose of the Report:

To present the Primary Care Strategy to the Governing Body following the period of consultation, as agreed at the November meeting.

Key Points:

- The Strategy covers the period to 2019 and has been updated to reflect comments made during the period of consultation
- The key work streams – Model of Care, Workforce and IT and Information Sharing – are being progressed with leads identified and work programmes being developed
- The enabling work streams – Commissioning, Premises and Patients, Carers and Stakeholder Engagement – are linked in to other ongoing work programmes such as the development of the Strategic Estates Plan
- Progress with the Strategy will be monitored through the multiagency Primary Care Quality Committee, a sub-committee of the Coventry Health and Wellbeing Board)
