Members' Meeting

Warwickshire North CCG is now fully delegated which means that some functions related to General Practice, previously carried out by NHS England are now the responsibility of the CCG. We discussed this process with member practices regarding how the CCG has organised this responsibility, and continued support from NHS England. Clear information was provided to members about contacts in the CCG if there are any concerns.

We also updated practices regarding the CASTLE register which aims to improve care for patients at the end of life by better information sharing and support for patients and families.

Protected Learning Time

The CCG supports GPs and practice staff for education on a monthly basis. In March a Coventry and Warwickshire wide event relating to Cancer was held. There were a variety of themes including early diagnosis, prevention, referral pathways, living beyond cancer and end of life care. It was very well attended and received.
